- Helmets are strongly recommended and required by law for riders 18 years of age and younger.
- Riders under the age of 14 must ride with an adult
- Riders must leave the ride if in the judgment of the tour staff the rider is too exhausted to continue

SAG assistance and rest stops will be provided on all course rides

Rides will take place rain or shine—there will be no refunds.

- 45 Mile** Intermediate and tandem riders will enjoy this scenic ride on mostly flat roads through orchards in bloom. Includes two rest stops.
- 25 Mile** This ride is for beginning and intermediate riders on flat country roads through orchards in bloom and. Includes on rest stop.
